DIVINE LITURGY PROPER

**Troparion (Tone 5):** Let us the faithful acclaim and worship the Word,\* co-eternal with the Father and the Spirit,\* and born of the Virgin for our salvation.\* For He willed to be lifted up on the cross in the flesh, to suffer death\* and to raise the dead by His glorious resurrection.

*Glory be to the Father and to the Son and to the Holy Spirit.*

**Kontakion (Tone 5):** You, my Saviour, descended to Hades,\* and as the Almighty, You shattered its gates.\* With Yourself You, as the Creator, raised the dead and shattered the sting of death,\* and delivered Adam from the curse, O Lover of Mankind.\* And so we cry out: “Save us, O Lord.”

*Now and for ever and ever. Amen.*

**Theotokion (Tone 5):** Rejoice, O impassable door of the Lord!\* Rejoice, O rampart and protection of those who have recourse to you!\* Rejoice, O tranquil haven and Virgin,\* who gave birth in the flesh to your Maker and God!\* Fail not to intercede for those\* who sing and worship the Child you bore.

**Prokeimenon (Tone 5):** You, O Lord, will guard us and will keep us\* from this generation and for ever.

*Verse:* Save me, O Lord, for there is no longer left a just man. (Psalm 11:8,2)

**A Reading from the letter of St. Paul to the Galatians (6:11-18):**

**Brothers and Sisters** See with what large letters I am writing to you with my own hand. It is those who want to make a good showing in the flesh who would force you to be circumcised, and only in order that they may not be persecuted for the cross of Christ. For even those who are circumcised do not themselves keep the law, but they desire to have you circumcised that they may boast in your flesh. But far be it from me to boast except in the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ, by which the world has been crucified to me, and I to the world. For neither circumcision counts for anything, nor uncircumcision, but a new creation. And as for all who walk by this rule, peace and mercy be upon them, and upon the Israel of God. From now on let no one cause me trouble, for I bear on my

body the marks of Jesus. The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with your spirit, brothers. Amen.
