SECOND SUNDAY after Descent of the Holy Spirit
DIVINE LITURGY PROPER

Troparion (T.1): Though the stone was sealed by the Judeans* and soldiers guarded Your most pure body,* You arose, O Savior, on the third day,* and gave life to the world.* And so the heavenly powers cried out to You, O Giver of Life;* Glory to your resurrection, O Christ!* Glory to Your kingdom!* Glory to Your saving plan,* O only Lover of Mankind.

Glory be to the Father and to the Son and to the Holy Spirit.

Kontakion (T.1): You arose in glory from the tomb* and with Yourself You raised the world.* All humanity acclaims You as God,* and death has vanished.* Adam exults, O Master,* and Eve, redeemed now from bondage, cries out for joy.* “You are the One, O Christ, Who offer resurrection to all.”

Now and for ever and ever. Amen.

Theotokion (T.1): When Gabriel uttered to You, O Virgin, his ‘Rejoice!’* – at that sound, the Master of all became flesh in You, the Holy Ark.* As the just David said,* You have become wider than the heavens carrying Your Creator.* Glory to Him Who dwelt in You!* Glory to Him Who came forth from You!* Glory to Him Who freed us through birth from You!

Prokimenon (T.1): Let Your mercy, O Lord,* be upon us,* as we have hoped in You.

verse: Rejoice in the Lord, O you just; praise befits the righteous.

A Reading of the Epistle of St. Paul to the Romans (2:10-16): Brethren, glory and honour and peace for everyone who does good, the Jew first and also the Greek. For God shows no partiality. All who have sinned apart from the law will also perish apart from the law, and all who have sinned under the law will be judged by the law. For it is not the hearers of the law who are righteous in God’s sight, but the doers of the law who will be justified. When Gentiles, who do not possess the law, do instinctively what the law requires, these, though not having the law, are a law to themselves. They show that what the law requires is written on their hearts, to which their own conscience also bears witness; and their conflicting thoughts will accuse or perhaps excuse them on the day when, according to my gospel, God, through Jesus Christ, will judge the secret thoughts of all.

Alleluia (T.1):

verse: God gives me vindication, and has subdued peoples under me. verse: Making great the salvation of the king, and showing mercy to His anointed, David, and to His posterity for ever.

Gospel: (Matthew 4:18-23)

Communion Verse: Praise the Lord from the heavens;* praise Him in the highest. Alleluia! (3x)
